

Area D 4-H College Scholarship



Scholarship

Amount \$250 College Scholarship will be awarded. This scholarship is sponsored by the Area D Horse Advisory Committee.

Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is for the 4-H Area D Horse Program to recognize and promote the total involvement and development of a 4-H horse club member in all aspects of the Florida and Area D 4-H Horse Program. The scholarship qualifications are based on all around involvement in the horse program and will not be solely awarded for show activities.

Rules

- Applicant must be an active 4-H member in District VIII and within the 4-H Area D Horse Program
- Applicant must be a Junior or Senior in High School

Selection and Interviews

- Portfolios will be screened and scored by a panel of volunteer judges
- Applicants will be notified the week of April 18, 2016 if they have been selected for an interview
- Interviews will be held at Clarcona Horseman's Park on Friday, May 6, 2016 starting at 5:00 PM
- The award will be announced during Area D Horse Show

- An original, completed copy of the Florida 4-H Portfolio
- A completed 1-2 page 4-H resume, using the “What are My Skills?” worksheet and format
- A three page narrative addressing the following:
 - Pages 1-2 “What Participating in the 4-H Horse Program Has Meant to Me.”
 - Page 3 “Why I Would Like to Have the Scholarship and What I Plan to Do With It.”
- Official or unofficial High School Transcripts
- Two Reference Forms
 - One from a school counselor, academic advisor, instructor or employer
 - One from your County Extension Agent

Procedure for Requesting Scholarship Payment

- Award check will be made out directly to recipient
- Check will be written when recipient provides College Enrollment verification and a thank you letter addressed to the Area D Advisory Committee has been received by August 17, 2016
- If recipient is a Junior in High School their award shall be held by the Area D Advisory Committee until the above criteria can be met except for the Thank You Letter which must be received by the August deadline of the year the award was announced.

Applications are due to Vanessa Swingle in Brevard County by Friday, April 1, 2016. Entries can be emailed or faxed.
