WE WOULD REQUEST THAT, UNLESS YOUR CHILDREN ARE TESTIFYING BEFORE THE BOARD, THEY REMAIN EITHER AT HOME OR OUTSIDE THE HEARING ROOM, WITH APPROPRIATE ADULT SUPERVISION.
