So please remember when you are picking up your child that you are probably in someone's neighborhood &
COURTESY COUNTS

- Don't arrive too early – this not only creates a hindrance for the people living along this residential street, but it also causes traffic delays and congestion! The congestion and confusion are detrimental to the safety of children walking to and from vehicles!
- Wait in a single file. Would an emergency response vehicle be able to maneuver through?
- Don't block driveways, mailboxes, disabled parking spaces or fire hydrants.
- Don't park on lawns.
- Don't block access to or the view from side streets.
- Don't back out onto any street from the school parking lot or from a side street! Motorists traveling down the road might not be prepared to stop so suddenly!
- Try to arrange your drop off / pick-up time *after* the peak hour rush (usually a mere 15 minutes!).
- Act, as *you* would want people to if this were *your* neighborhood.
