Entry Deadline - January 25, 2016
to any Seminole County Library Branch.

Award winners will be required to read or present their entry at **Teen Read Fest 2016**,
Thursday, March 10th at 7:00 p.m.

Written Entry

- ✓ May be a poem or short story on any subject.
- ✓ Must be typed and able to be read aloud in 3 minutes or less.

Video Entry

- ✓ May be a film on any subject or a commercial on reading/an individual book. (Note: if you mention where to get a book, mention the Library or Media Center).
- ✓ Must be 3 minutes or less in length and submitted in digital format.
- ✓ Must include a typewritten script.
- ✓ Digital entries submitted to dkeyes@seminolecountyfl.gov.

Poster Entry

- ✓ Must be a poster designed to advertise reading or an individual book.
- ✓ Must be in digital format designed using any software or freeware for computer art, with finished standard poster size of 24" x 36".
- ✓ May be in any artistic style.
- ✓ Digital entries submitted to dkeyes@seminolecountyfl.gov.

All Entries

Label each entry with: Student Name(s), School, Teacher, & Contact Email.

- All entries must be the original work of the entering student(s).
- **Entries must not include obscene language or visuals.**
- Submitted materials will not be returned.
- By submitting entries, students agree to have their pictures taken and published on the Seminole County Public Library website, social media, and shown on Seminole Government Television.
