Cutting Apart Pattern Pieces, Applying Fusible
Interfacing, Placement of States/Ironing,
Applique (sewing around states)**



Participants are required to provide their own sewing machine in great working condition plus basic sewing supplies including: iron & ironing board (travel size works well), thread, bobbin, machine needles, scissors, seam ripper, and sewing pins – plus long extension, multi-plug outlet, scotch & packing tape. **Pre-Washed COTTON FABRIC: 2 yards fabric min 42 inches wide for quilt front (pictured tan/white), select 5 fabrics for state shapes (15 x 42 in. of each), 6 yards of Fusible Interfacing (Pellon #805). We will construct only the quilt top. If you like, a local quilter will machine quilt the project, \$25.**
