- **Be an Informed Voter:** Come to this informational seminar presenting the pros & cons of the Constitutional Amendments that will be on the November ballot. **Free. No registration required.**
- **Book Club:** The second Wednesday of every month! Come join your fellow book enthusiasts on Wed. Sept. 9<sup>th</sup> for a lively, in-depth discussion of The Memory Keeper's Daughter by Kim Edwards. Copies of the book are available at circulation desk for check out. **Free. - **Container Gardening:** Have you considered growing flowers or vegetables in raised beds or containers? If so, this class, will give you the information you'll need to get your container garden started. **Free. Registration is required.**
- **Put Pain in its Place:** Get the facts about osteoarthritis pain and learn strategies for controlling and even preventing pain.
